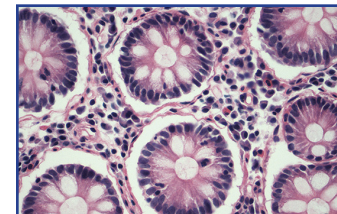


## Gastrointestinal Pathology

Our diagnostic techniques include routine histopathology, immunohistochemistry, in situ hybridization, molecular diagnostics, flow cytometry, and electron microscopy. The Yale Gastrointestinal Pathology Program also plays a critical role in the liver transplant service.
